## Town Centre Regeneration Update

As a council, we are committed to revitalising our market towns. Dunstable Town Council has undertaken five projects in partnership with us, using £1.25million allocated from our Market Town Regeneration Fund. In 2017 we joint-funded the new splash play park and the town ranger cleaning machines. In 2018 a new arch and gates at Priory Gardens were put in place. We also offered £1million on facelifts for independent shops and businesses across the region. The Saracen's Head, Lombardo's deli, Café Latte, Allframe, and the Conference Centre have all benefitted, along with vacant units. We're supporting these businesses to boost your town.

Last year we asked for your ideas on how to improve Dunstable. You told us you wanted to prioritise pedestrians, as they're the ones spending money in the shops and businesses. So we've made £1.5million worth of improvements to widen the pavements and reduced the road width to create the feel of a traditional market town, and we've pedestrianised Middle Row. The high street had become akin to a dual carriageway when it was the old A5. We want only local traffic to come into town, rather than using Dunstable as a through-route. And we're adding trees and benches to help encourage pedestrians back into town. We're incorporating drainage solutions to take away storm water to help with the flooding that's affected the town. We've also used permeable paving which lets the water seep away into underground drains.

All these investments will help achieve our ambition to give you back your high street.

## Celebrating 10 years of Dunstable in Bloom

2019 marks the 10th anniversary of Dunstable in Bloom and the town will be entering the Anglia in Bloom competition again this year as well as organising the annual best Front Garden, Basket and Container display competitions. This year's theme is 'Plants for the Senses' and local residents and organisations are encouraged to use plants for touch, taste, sound, smell and sight. To get you started here are ten good plants for the senses.

## Dunstable's Green Spaces

### Touch

- **Lamb's Ears:** downy leaves that resemble the ears of a lamb.
- **Jerusalem Sage:** soft, downy leaves and stems with pretty, yellow flowers.

### Taste

- **Spearmint:** a vigorous growing herb, which tastes great with peas or new potatoes.
- **Rosemary:** highly fragrant leaves used to flavour meat and fish. Its scent is wonderful.

### Sound

- **Greater Quaking Grass:** rustles in the wind with nodding, lantern-like heads of flowers.
- **Fountain Grass:** long, evergreen grass, with bristly spikelets.

### Smell

- **Chocolate Cosmos:** beautiful, maroon flowers give off a chocolate/vanilla scent - a big hit with the kids!
- **Lemon Scented Geranium:** leaves that smell of lemon when rubbed.

### Sight

- **Sunflowers:** bright, bold looking flower that can grow 30 cm in height in a week in ideal conditions.
- **Love-in-a-Mist:** sun-loving, bright blue flowers.

The farmers and craft market has grown over the last year with regular bread and cake sellers now joining the talented crafters each month.

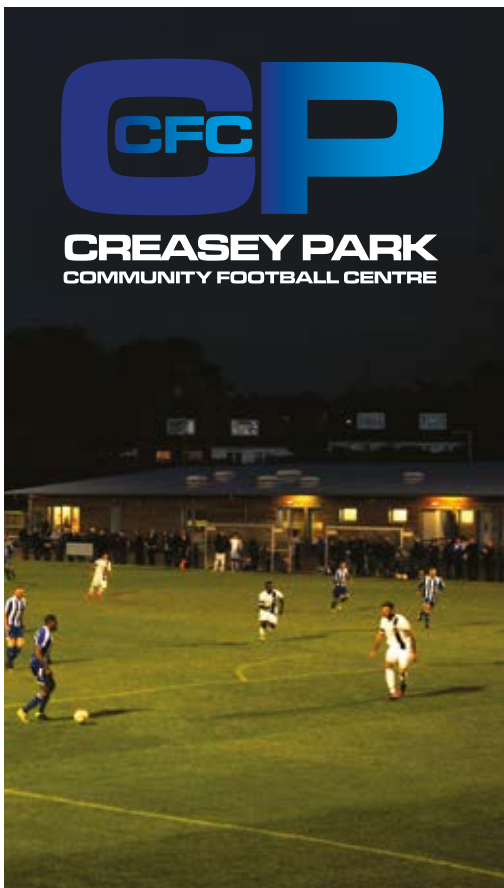
