April marked the end of the £1.144million High Street Heritage Action Zone (HSHAZ) project with the completion of works to the frontage of 21-23 the High Street. The town has benefitted significantly from the HSHAZ scheme's contributions to events and activities in recent years.

In light of the loss of this resource, I'm delighted that the Town Council have agreed to increase the number of summer activities for young people to one each week during the summer holidays, along with continuing a similar programme of larger events as last year.

I would like to extend my sincere thanks to Councillor Liz Jones for her time and commitment she has given to the town and the Council during her two year stint as Mayor. I am proud of the Council's support for the role of Mayor and civic traditions and look forward to working with our new Mayor, Councillor Louise O'Riordan, to support local groups and represent the town.





A project to install inclusive play equipment in the Grove House Gardens Play Area has created a new-look play area open to all.

The play area in Grove House Gardens, in the centre of Dunstable, has benefited from a major refurbishment thanks to funding from Central Bedfordshire Council and the governmentfunded UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF).

This provided grant funding for new surfacing and nine pieces of play equipment including a wheelchair accessible roundabout, an inclusive seesaw and a sensory panel with 'talk tubes'. The new installations are next to the existing play equipment to allow children of all abilities to play together.

The park was officially reopened on Friday 5 April by Councillor Mary Walsh, Central Bedfordshire Council's Executive Member for Planning and Waste, and former Town Mayor of Dunstable, Councillor Liz Jones, and is already welcoming local children in a safe and inclusive space.

Councillor Walsh, also Chair of the UKSPF Local Partnership Group, said: "The addition of the inclusive equipment to the play area is a great asset to the gardens and to the whole local community. The new equipment now provides an inclusive environment for children of all ages that gives opportunities for both physical and social interaction, while they explore, learn and have fun.

Former Town Mayor of Dunstable, Councillor Liz Jones, said: "Providing additional inclusive play to the park in Grove House Gardens has been received exceptionally well. It's wonderful to see so many children enjoying the new equipment, helping and supporting those less able to take part and engage in new activities. Thank you to officers of both Dunstable Town Council and Central Bedfordshire Council for making this happen for our community through funding of the UKSPF and Section 106 money."









### 60 Years of **Britain in Bloom**

CHIERRATING SO YEARS OF RIOD

2024 marks the 60th anniversary of the nationwide community gardening campaign Britain in Bloom. Started in 1964 by the British Tourist Authority it is now run and managed by the Royal Horticultural Society (RHS).

Over six decades, millions of people have participated, enabling them to get to know their neighbours, make new friends and forge stronger community networks. For this special anniversary, the theme for In Bloom across the country is friendship to celebrate the many social benefits forged through plants and gardening.

In 2024, Dunstable in Bloom, in partnership with the Town Council, will again be entering the regional Anglia in Bloom competition. Judges visit during July, and they will be shown a number of environmental projects across the town in particular showcasing the many friendships and social benefits that are often achieved when people come together through gardening and environmental management.

One such project is the unique Physic Border in Priory Gardens which is cared for by a small but dedicated group of volunteers. Mary, then 79, became involved at the creation of the garden in 2013. She says: "Meeting




every Friday to care for these interesting 12th century herbal plants, learning about their uses for medicines, dyes and cooking; enjoying the fresh air and exercise followed by our rewarding tea break and chat has certainly given me a new lease of life. Our friendship has bloomed!"

Dunstable in Bloom has been active in Dunstable since 2010 and has been instrumental in securing many Gold medals for the town, as well as nurturing friendships and promoting and showcasing the work of community groups and local volunteers. Good luck Dunstable in Bloom for 2024!



NGYT's project leads, husband and wife team, Laura and David Lloyd said "Firstly we'd like to thank DTC for entrusting us and the BBB Group to lead this vital Arts project; one of discovery, development and showcasing creatives from across Dunstable's diverse communities. As organisations we take huge pride in supporting artists (who may not see themselves in this way) to recognise and place value in their talents, stories and voices.'

Over the course of the year, NGYT and BBB Group will work with and for Dunstable's creative community to identify their needs, supporting them to develop their artistry and collaboratively shaping platforms for them to share their gifts with local audiences.

David added: "There is nothing worse than being told what you need, or being invited to contribute to a planning meeting, only to discover the plan is already written; we are not here to place our ideas onto people, this is very much a grassroots up approach, wherein we need the vision and dreams to come from those who live and breathe the local community and share our passion to celebrate and showcase local creativity."
